


Children's COVID-19 Modified Shuttle Service

Due to COVID-19 impacts, Children's shuttles are operating on frequency based schedules. See information below for the frequencies of each line and the first and last departure times of each shuttle line. All frequencies and departure times are approximate. Children's is providing the highest level of service possible given COVID-19 impacts and constrained resources.

COVID-19 Infection Prevention on Children's Shuttles:

- Masks required on Children's shuttles
- Shuttle capacity limited to 6 passengers
- Shuttles are equipped with a plastic barrier separating the driver from riders
- Shuttles are loading from back to front
- Increased frequency of shuttle cleaning
- Hand sanitizer available on all shuttles



Use Link Light Rail

Travel between Downtown Seattle and Husky stadium takes just 6 minutes. To travel downtown, take the Gold Line, bus routes 65/67 or 31/32/75 to UW station and take Link light rail to Westlake station.



Use Metro Route 75

To travel between the hospital campus and Sand Point Learning Center (SPLC) or 70th and Sand Point Way, use Metro route 75 on Sand Point Way.

Shuttle Rider Information and Policies

- Shuttles run Monday to Friday, except on Children's recognized holiday's and the Friday after Thanksgiving.
- Always scan your Children's-issued ID badge at the reader inside the shuttle when boarding.
- Shuttles load only at designated stops. For your safety, do not chase the shuttle after it has left a stop. Use designated walkways when approaching shuttles at all stops.
- Passengers are required to wear a seatbelt on the shuttle.
- Keep all food and drinks in closed containers.
- Do not discuss patient information on the shuttle.
- Transporting items on the shuttles is allowed if the item can fit under, or be secured in, a vacant seat next to the rider accompanying it.
- Children must weigh over 40 lbs to ride the shuttle.
